According to Rhode Island General Law § 31-10-6, (b)(2)(iii), a person under the age of eighteen (18) must complete a minimum of fifty (50) hours of driving experience, with ten (10) of those hours being completed at night. The fifty hours can be completed with a commercial driving school or any other supervised driver.

- **FACT:** In the United States, it is illegal to buy or sell organs and tissue for transplantation.
- **FACT:** Don’t disqualify yourself. People of all ages and medical histories should consider themselves potential donors. Advances in medicine continue to allow more people to donate and potential donors are carefully screened prior to transplant.
