



Moving live fish is a **SERIOUS CRIME**

Don't let others destroy your fishery

Please report anyone transporting or stocking live fish

Illegal fish introductions can destroy valuable sport fisheries and native populations. Penalties may include:

- lifetime revocation of Wyoming hunting and fishing privileges
- a fine up to \$10,000
- up to one-year in jail

AND civil penalties in an amount not to exceed the costs incurred by the Department in removing the fish from the waters affected by the violation.

Know the law



- No fish shall be stocked in Wyoming waters without department authorization.
- Any fish placed on a stringer, in a container, in a live well, or not released immediately to the water shall be considered reduced to the possession of the angler AND MUST BE KILLED PRIOR TO BEING TRANSPORTED FROM THE WATER OF ORIGIN.
- No fish that has been reduced to possession shall be released alive without prior written approval from the Department.
- Live baitfish shall not be transported by land in the live well of a watercraft.
- It is unlawful to release, abandon or allow to escape by any unused baitfish or any fish that has been kept in an aquarium.
